RE: INQUIRY INTO RECYCLING AND WASTE MANAGEMENT

My view is that it is important to establish a Victorian recycling industry and that public borrowing capacity should be utilised to establish this, not private venture capital.

Further that this industry should not involve the export of waste but rather its reduction and treatment here.

We need to establish a 10c refund on bottles and cans. The principles for this move are well established as are examples, e.g. South Australia. The milk and beverage industries should be targeted for immediate action.

Unnecessary single use plastics should be prohibited and alternatives sponsored with the support of public funds and industry penalties, if necessary.

The systematic provision of green waste facilities should be established, for built up urban areas especially and factored into all new developments as a matter of course.
