YOUR SUBMISSION

The use of cannabis has been shown to be less harmful than that of alcohol and is easier on a person's health than tobacco. If we aim to be a fair state in our use of drugs, it only makes sense for cannabis to be available for personal, regulated use to be in line with that of alcohol and tobacco.

The current illegal distribution and use of cannabis will continue should the current status quo remain, resulting in unregulated product being sold to inexperienced individuals, which may be of poor or harmful quality. Regulation may ensure that all cannabis in circulation is safe for use.

The sale of cannabis may be taxed, adding extra revenue to the state. Looking at examples of states that took on this change in US shows massive success. I encourage Parliament to study these good examples.
