YOUR SUBMISSION

I believe that legalising the use of the drug for both medicinal and recreational purposes should be the over-arching nature of the legislation. Then exceptions made regarding supplying to underage persons, supplying to already intoxicated persons, driving or operating mechanical devices under the influence ... and so on.

Growing, Distribution and Sales could be regulated with particular attention to labelling of potency, THC/CBD ratios, and sources. Notwithstanding this, it should be legal for an individual to grow up to 3 plants for personal use only and access to the seeds, or seedlings, be made available and legal.

By regulating cannabis in this way it takes the growing, distribution and sale of of the product out of the hands of criminal gangs and thus reduces public exposure to other drugs or contaminated cannabis products.

I believe that these legislative changes would be in the greater public interest and also assist those, such as myself, who suffer chronic pain and are averse to the use of opium based products.
