Hello Inquiry,

I have concerns about the community consultation process for the Abbotsford site. I am in favour of improving social (government owned) housing, and I am in no way opposed to a degree of increased housing density close to the CBD - it makes sense. However, I have concerns that you can only sell a public asset once.
