To the Secretary,

I live in an inner city suburb. Each day I see homeless people sleeping on the street. Five years ago it was very unusual to see people sleeping along Bourke St in the city. Melbourne is in the midst of a housing crisis. There are 35,000 people on public housing waiting lists. Homelessness is a growing illness that can be resolved if we have the will. There are many apartments being built close to the city. It should be mandatory that good public housing is a major part of any inner city development. In the long term adequate housing results in greater equity and a better environment for all. Not just those who cannot afford it.

Public land should be used for 100% public housing – not sold off for private development.

If the Government plan goes ahead private developers will make big profits while people in public housing will lose out.
