To the Secretary,

The governments stance on public infrastructure needs to change. We the public do not want sell offs to pay interest debt to the RBA and other foreign owned banks, we want investment in our communities with our taxpayer money. Now do your job and do as we ask!

And while you're at it, abolish the RBA and establish our own commonwealth of Australia owned and controlled central bank.

Melbourne is in the midst of a housing crisis. There are 35,000 people on public housing waiting lists. Homelessness is growing.

The Government's plans to demolish hundreds of homes and replace them with thousands of expensive private apartments, while providing a paltry 10% increase in new public or social housing is not good enough.

We need a new build of public housing like we had in the 1960s. This public land should be used for 100% public housing – not sold off for private development.

If the Government plan goes ahead private developers will make big profits while people in public housing will lose out.
