To the Secretary,

Melbourne is in the midst of a housing crisis. There are 35,000 people on public housing waiting lists. Homelessness is growing.

The Government's plans to demolish hundreds of homes and replace them with thousands of expensive private apartments, while providing a paltry 10% increase in new public or social housing is not good enough. This is not even enforced in developments.

We need a new build of public housing like we had in the 1960s. This public land should be used for 100% public housing – not sold off for private development.

If the Government plan goes ahead private developers will make big profits while people in public housing not to mention the whole community will lose out.

The social housing needs to be mixed through the suburbs and communities so that it is not ghettoized. The public and private housing needs to be sustainable
