As a pensioner forced to spend more than half my income on private rental accomodation I am dismayed by the State Governments plans to privatise public housing. The plans to demolish much of the existing public housing and sell off the land whilst only creating 1000 new homes whilst only creating 1000 new affordable dwellings contravenes the rights of the tenants in those properties, many of whom have made these places their homes for up to 30 years. There appears to be no transparency about what is going to happen to these tenants. Handing housing over to community organisations means that they are no longer owned by us the people of Victoria.

These plans do little to address the housing crisis plunging pensioners like myself into ongoing poverty.
