As a resident of [REDACTED] Retirement Village I wish to bring to the attention of the Committee the inequity of the Council rates paid by village residents compared to those residing in regular housing in the Geelong area.

My unit is leased and I do not actually own the small piece of land on which it is built. The roads, lighting and other infrastructure has been provided by the village owner and is not a drain on Council resources. But the rates are similar to fully owned properties on large blocks of land.

Some Councils allow a discounted rate system for retirement properties - the Geelong Council does not. I would like to see the new legislation address this problem and include in the Act that ALL Councils should adopt this fairer system of rating for retirement housing.
