I am a retiree, living in a retirement village, in
Queensborough,

The very high rates that Killembik is charging is unjust
& like many other pensioners living in retirement
villages are struggling to meet the high cost of, rates,
electricity, food, medical expenses, insurance, & so on
It is not fair to pay such high rates for the
little services we receive from the State.

We are also paying \$365 - 70^c monthly for
maintenance at the village, so there is very
little left from our fortnightly pension. I
don't know how we can afford another increase
in the rates & all the other expenses, pensioners
have to pay.

Trust the Victorian Parliamentary Inquiry into
Retirement Housing costs is of some benefit to
pensioners.
