Parks and waterways focus for environmental infrastructure inquiry

A parliamentary committee will hold a public hearing for its inquiry into environmental infrastructure for growing populations this Wednesday, 12 May.

The Legislative Assembly's Environment and Planning Committee has been investigating community access to parks and open space as well as sporting fields, forest and bushland, wildlife corridors and waterways.

Government related agencies, including Parks Victoria and Melbourne Water will appear before the Committee via Zoom from 12 pm.

The Committee received 262 submissions and is due to hand down its report by 30 June.
