The Coalition Government is getting on with the job of rolling out Victoria's new integrity system. This includes:

- Independent Broad-based Anti-corruption Commission (IBAC)
- Victorian Inspectorate (VI)
- Freedom of Information Commissioner
- Public Interest Monitor (PIM)
- Judicial Complaints Commission (JCC)
- new Codes of Conduct

IBAC will be at the pinnacle of the integrity system.

Investigative & examination powers

- IBAC is vested with important investigative & examination powers



Commonwealth legislation

The Commonwealth Government has introduced legislation to support Victoria's integrity system reforms.

- Telecommunications Interception and Other Legislation Amendment (State Bodies) Bill 2012



Victorian Inspectorate

The Victorian Inspectorate will provide robust oversight of the new integrity system.



Public Interest Monitor

The Public Interest Monitor will act in the public interest in applications for covert and special investigative warrants.



FOI Commissioner

The FOI Commissioner will be independent of the executive arm of government, and supported by an independent office.



Budget

- The most significant investment in Victoria's public sector integrity system ever.
- \$200 million over the next four years for the Government's public sector integrity measures.
