As a concerned Victorian I am writing to you to urge you to request the Premier's phone records as well as those of his Chief of Staff and all other related persons in this inquiry, to ascertain who sent messages during the six-minutes of missing communication. Particularly who sent the message to Former Chief Commissioner Ashton at 1.19pm. The fact that he cannot recollect who it was is both disturbing and disappointing. This would be crucial evidence in relation to the decision made to use private security, and finally name the person who made that fateful decision that ultimately led to the deaths of nearly 800 Victorians.

Please make these documents available to the public, allowing for complete transparency during this inquiry. I thank you for your work in this matter, and look forward to hearing from you and the eventual outcome of this inquiry.
