

## Inquiry into the Government's response to the Covid-19 pandemic

### YOUR SUBMISSION

#### Submission:

As an innocent victim of an ongoing government/state crime and public service corruption for the last thirty-nine years and due to the absence of any decent/effective anti-corruption mechanisms available in Victoria to Australian citizens, and to Catholic families in particular, I categorically oppose the revised, yet bluntly totalitarian, Omnibus Bill that was passed as part of the Victorian Government's response to the Covid-19 pandemic. Therefore I kindly request the Public Accounts and Estimates Committee to:

1. Ensure that the proposed expanded powers of detention have been scrapped from the Omnibus Bill, specifically whether the proposed new Sections 30 (1A) and 200A have been scrapped.
2. Oppose any expanded powers of detention for 'authorised officers' beyond those powers already available in the Public Health and Wellbeing Act, and specifically:
  - 2.1 To oppose any power to detain indefinitely, as in for as long as an 'authorised officer reasonably believes' a person is 'likely' to fail to comply with a 'direction'.
  - 2.2 To oppose any powers of detention or to enter a person's home without warrant merely on the 'reasonable belief' that a person is only 'reasonably likely' to refuse to comply with a 'direction'.
  - 2.3 To oppose any powers of detention based on an 'authorised officer' merely reasonably believing that a person is a 'high risk' person (i.e. notified as COVID positive or a close contact of such a person) rather than the 'authorised officer' having to know and have evidence of the person's COVID positive status.

As a victim of unprovoked yet long-term government harassment I am terrified by the new/additional powers given to 'public servants' by the Omnibus Bill.

During the last thirty-nine years my catholic family and I have been targeted by a vast number of corrupt public servants, both Victorian and Commonwealth (documentation available upon written request) who apparently misused public funds to fabricate false accusations, attack and harass without any accountability and/or legitimate reason under the prevailing (i.e. pre-Omnibus) public service provisions!

I believe that the unfortunate passing of the Omnibus Bill provides our 'public servants'/'authorised officers' with increased opportunities to continue their apparently criminal conduct, avoid responsibility for their criminal actions and, introduce new target groups of Australian people [REDACTED]
