For what it is worth, I spent 2 weeks in quarantine with my wife in April in the Four Points by Sheraton in the Docklands and subsequently I was moved for 6 nights on my own to Rydges on Swanston, my wife returned to our home in WA.

The Four Points would not allow any external deliveries except those from Woolworths ordered on line. Rydges apparently allowed anything from anywhere and this struck me as strange, 2 hotels with different threat levels.

At about 6.00 a.m, on the day of my departure from Rydges on 28 April, I had a knock on my door and there was a big man (tall and broad) smartly dressed in a dark suit and tie who had come to collect me and took me along the corridor where there were 3 people all dressed in PPE head to toe who processed my release paperwork etc. IMPORTANTLY THE MAN IN THE SUIT WAS NOT WEARING A MASK WHICH I THOUGHT ODD. I was taken downstairs and exited through the carpark past a bevy of PPE dressed personnel.
