As a mother of 3 beautiful children who wishes nothing but the best for my children, I'm am deeply concerned about the new vaccine registry legislation that may pass through to myself and many other law abiding citizens. My first child was fully vaccinated, she grew up to have many behavioural problems and is moderately deaf, I know when she was born her hearing was fine but I noticed after 2 years not much was registering, I cannot prove vaccination was the cause of this disability but I cannot prove it didn't either.
