Dear Sir/Madam,

Re: Social Services Legislation Amendment (No Jab, No Pay) Bill 2015

I believe this bill breaches fundamental human rights under the human rights charter which contains twenty basic rights that **promote and protect the values of freedom, respect, equality and dignity**. The following points demonstrate where these rights are going to be breached through the introduction of this bill.

- 1) **(Section 8) Your right to recognition and equality before the law.**
Everyone is entitled to equal and effective protection against discrimination, and to enjoy their human rights without discrimination.

This Bill, if introduced will remove my children's right to access childcare services within the community. If I attempt to enrol them in childcare, a service that should be available to everyone, they will be refused and discriminated against.

It is my human right to choose not to vaccinate my children. By making that choice under this law, my children will be discriminated against.

- 2) **(Section 10) Your right to protection from torture and cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment.** Specifically - People must not be subjected to medical treatment or experiments without their full and informed consent."

This Bill, will be enforcing coercion while claiming at the same time that the right of the individual to make a choice is not being taken away. The consequences however for not giving consent to medical treatments in this instance will create a situation where a person is discriminated against (human right).

3) **(Section 14) Your right to freedom of thought, conscience, religion and belief.** People have the freedom to think and believe what they want, for example, religion. They can do this in public or private, as part of a group or alone.

This Bill will in fact penalise my right to freedom of thought, conscience, religion and belief. It will openly say that my beliefs are wrong and cannot be supported within society. It will even go so far as to take money from me because of my beliefs.

4) **(Section 17) Your right to protection of families and children.** Families are entitled to protection. Children have the same rights as adults with added protection according to their best interests.

Families are entitled to be protected by the state. The safety of vaccines cannot be guaranteed for anyone and has not been proven. There is currently no compensation fund set up within Australia to cater for the vaccine injured. My choice is to protect my family from harm and this right is supported under the human rights charter. This right will not be supported if this Bill is passed.

Please consider carefully how this Bill will affect the rights of all Australians now and in the future.
