Subject: No jab no play legislation

I am writing to you in relation to the No Jab No Play Legislation.
According to the "Convention of the rights of a child" document it states below.
I would like to draw your attention to point 3 of the below legislation and point out that the "no jab no play policy" would discriminate against children whose parents choose not to vaccinate

Point 1 also states "parents have primary responsibility for upbringing and development and the best interest of the child is their primary concern."

As a parent my primary concern is to protect my child from being injected with vaccines that have many possible side effects as listed on the information provided by the vaccine manufacturer.

Point 2

States parties shall provide assistance to ensure the development of children...with facilities and services. Denying unvaccinated children of child care this is a clear breach of this act.
Below is the section of the act I refer to

CONVENTION OF THE RIGHTS OF A CHILD.

Article 18

1. States Parties shall use their best efforts to ensure recognition of the principle that both parents have common responsibilities for the upbringing and development of the child. Parents or, as the case may be, legal guardians, have the primary responsibility for the upbringing and development of the child. The best interests of the child will be their basic concern.

2. For the purpose of guaranteeing and promoting the rights set forth in the present Convention, States Parties shall render appropriate assistance to parents and legal guardians in the performance of their child-rearing responsibilities and shall ensure the development of institutions, facilities and services for the care of children.

3. States Parties shall take all appropriate measures to ensure that children of working parents have the right to benefit from child-care services and facilities for which they are eligible.

I would like these concerns to be made clear to those responsible for the enquiry and for a written response to my be emailed to me.
