I am oppose this legislation, which would see children banned from childcare centres and pre school education services. I am disgusted and upset children will be discriminated based on vaccination status to the open-ended schedule.

I have chosen not to vaccinate both of my children due to a friends child having an adverse reaction to a vaccine. Their case was reported to the TGA however this I am disgusted this is still given. I have done a lot of reading and found that no drug trials information every has to be released. They can keep doing trials until they get the result they want and none of the never are exposed. Don't you find this scary and dishonest, surely you can't force this on anyone? What if it was your child or a family member, I am sure you would do some research and once knowing the risk do what is best for your child?

I am on a mother group on FB with over 4000 members. So many mums write their child had a fever or a reaction after having their shots, however are told this is perfectly normal. I can confidently say my kids are hardly ever sick and if they do have a cold bounce back. The children I know who were vaccinated are always sick. Do you think maybe more money could be spent doing trials on Vaccinated Vs Non vaccinated. I think you would be alarmed by the results.

I personally have had tinnitus as a side affect of anti malaria tablets. I was not informed of the risks of taking the medication. The first two years I really struggled and knocked my confidence and ability to concentrate as a practising yoga teacher.

I therefore and not willing to consent to giving dangerous medications to my family.

We choose to use homeopathy, by following a strict program by issac golden. Eat a healthy diet and create and safe and happy space to raise my children.

I am concerned if this is past in QLD and Victoria, NSW will follow suit. We are struggling to raise a small family financially. The added stress of me not being able to work does not create and healthy environment for my kids. They also deserve the same education as every other child.
