**Subject:** Social Services Legislation Amendment (No Jab, No Pay) Bill 2015 submission

To Whom It May Concern,

I write on behalf of my husband & I. We totally disagree with & oppose the Social Services Legislation Amendment (No Jab, No Pay, No Play) Bill 2015.

My family has a history of autoimmune diseases. My mum is fighting a crippling autoimmune disease that she's had for most of her life. I also suffer from a similar autoimmune disorder. We have chosen not to vaccinate our 3 year old daughter Zi Li as she suffers terribly from food allergies & a low immune system. If her diet is not free from sugar, dairy, nut and gluten, she either ends up with high fevers for nights on end, eczema or bad coughs, colds & flus. She is being looked after by our Integrative medical doctor who advised us, her immune system is compromised & her digestive system is weak. Given that information, and knowing our family genetics is inherently weak,

exposing my child's body to the amounts of toxicity found in vaccines will compromise her health and well being, and could be life threatening.

There is no way in the world that I would let my child be vaccinated. Should she suffer from some adverse reaction, mild or severe, there is no safety net, no vaccine injury compensation in place.

Vaccines do carry significant risk of harm and are never 100% effective. I know of a family with kids, all up to date with their vaccinations. The young boys contracted whooping cough. Their mother (fully vaccinated) contracted whooping cough from her sons and spread it through her workplace.

I have learned from friends, how vaccines can harm families. A friend's 2 month old boy had his first round of vaccinations and his mum had to nurse him through 6 weeks of high fevers. Another friend who's baby son, did not stop crying for 3 months solid, once he received his first round of shots.

Another mother gave birth to a stillborn and the doctors managed to bring her baby, back to life. At 18 months of age, the doctors convinced her to give her daughter the MMR vaccine. After that she has not walked or talked again. She is now 10 years old and disabled. Vaccine injury is real to me and my community.

We demand for independent vaccine safety research. And not research funded by Vaccine companies.

I am a mother who works full time. If this No Jab No Pay Policy passes, I will not succumb to the discrimination you place on my family. I will be forced to stop work and apply for Centrelink Unemployment benefits. Under no circumstances will I consider vaccinating my child.

What you are wanting to achieve out of this policy will not happen. It will only increase unemployment and will not change the vaccination rates.
