**Police and emergency services: police — Ballarat**

**22.** Ms KNIGHT to ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services —

- (1) Has the minister instructed Victoria Police or the Department of Justice to station additional police in Ballarat.
- (2) What is the planned number of additional full-time equivalent police to be provided to the Ballarat police service area in:
  - (a) 2011;
  - (b) 2012;
  - (c) 2013;
  - (d) 2014.

**ANSWER:**

I am advised that:

- (1) The government is conscious of the need for sufficient police resources across the state, and is aware of the needs of regional Victorian communities such as Ballarat. That is why the government is committed to making Victoria's streets safe again by addressing statewide police shortages and restoring public safety. Front-line police numbers will be boosted by an additional 1700 recruits, including 100 additional transit police.

It is not the role of government to 'station' police in any location: rather that is the task of police command.

- (2) During the 2010–11 year an extra 600 police officers were allocated across Victoria, including 450 new recruits and 150 existing officers who were deployed back to front-line duties; the Ballarat police service area (PSA) received 25 of these officers.

A further 400 police officers have been allocated for 2011–12, of which 22 officers are being placed within western region division 3, which includes the Ballarat PSA. These extra officers will be out in their local communities by mid-2012.

The timing and size of any further increases in the number of police members assigned to Ballarat is the responsibility of the Chief Commissioner of Police, and will take into account matters such as local requirements resulting from the opening of new police stations.

**Housing: fees, charges, taxes, levies and other costs**

**371(ak).** Ms D'AMBROSIO to ask the Minister for Sport and Recreation for the Minister for Housing with reference to each fee, charge, tax and levy, or any other cost payable by members of the public or incorporated associations in the minister's portfolio:

- (1) What is its name.
- (2) What is the current schedule or rate of charge.

- (3) What is the scheduled increase in the next 12 months.
- (4) How many changes are reviewed or decided upon and determined by government or its departments or agencies.
- (5) What was the total revenue for each charge in 2010–11.

The details of state taxes and charges are set out in the relevant legislation or subordinate legislation, which is subject to approval or disallowance by either house of the Parliament. This has been the practice of successive governments.

More information can be found in 2011–12 budget paper no. 5 — Statement of Finances, which details the revised estimates of state revenue and the public account.

The value of a penalty or fee unit is determined under the *Monetary Unit Act 2004* and fixed each year by notice published in the Victorian Government Gazette. Other state fees and charges are periodically gazetted and published on the websites of administering departments and agencies.

- (1) When was the minister informed of the plan.
- (2) Why did the minister allow the change.
- (3) Is the minister aware that no prior consultation was given to any affected stakeholders.

**ANSWER:**

I am informed that:

- In October 2010, the Mount Alexander Shire Council adopted a waste management strategy that proposed several changes to the way it delivers sustainable waste management services to the community.

- I understand one of these changes was to discontinue the provision of commercial waste collection services, so that it no longer provides garbage and recycling bins to properties classed as ‘commercial premises’, including retail, wholesale and service business premises.
- I further understand that the council recently awarded its waste collection contract to a new provider, which commences in April 2012, and has determined this changeover to be an appropriate time to discontinue its involvement in commercial waste collection.
- Local government operates as a separate tier of government, and it is for the council to consider and determine such matters, including the level of appropriate consultation.
- In this regard, I note that, to assist businesses with the transition to the new waste collection arrangements, including alternative options for businesses, the council is providing information sessions throughout February and March. Details are available from the council.
- I also understand that it is not an uncommon practice amongst councils to not provide a commercial waste collection service and for such properties to make their own arrangements with private operators.

**Environment and climate change: Chewton pine plantation**

**2643.** Ms EDWARDS to ask the Minister for Environment and Climate Change — with reference to the pine plantation at Chewton:

- (1) Does the minister know where it is located.
- (2) Is the minister aware of any consultation with the broader local community.
- (3) Will the minister visit the plantation and meet with concerned community members.
- (4) Is the minister aware that the plantation has no historical significance in regards to the Castlemaine Diggings National Heritage Park.
- (5) Is the plantation part of the Castlemaine Diggings National Heritage Park; if not, are there plans to include it in Castlemaine Diggings National Heritage Park.

**ANSWER:**

- (1) The pine plantation is situated within the Castlemaine Diggings National Heritage Park adjacent to the Chewton township.
- (2) The Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE) are responsible for fire management across all public land, and have undertaken consultation with Parks Victoria as the land manager, local residents, and members of the Country Fire Authority. Bushfire risk mitigation works have been undertaken within the plantation.
- (3) I have already contacted the community members concerned and advised them of DSE’s response to this issue.
- (4) The plantation was a school plantation that has been harvested, and the plantation is now primarily regrowth. Advice from Heritage Victoria is that although the plantation has local historical significance, it is not intrinsic to the values of the Castlemaine Diggings National Heritage Park.
- (5) The plantation is within the Castlemaine Diggings National Heritage Park.

**Agriculture and food security: Harcourt apple growers — storm damage**

**2644.** Ms EDWARDS to ask the Minister for Agriculture and Food Security — with reference to the recent storm damage to the Harcourt apple growers:

- (1) Has the minister inspected the serious damage sustained by the orchards.
- (2) Is the minister aware that several of the orchards have suffered a 50 per cent loss of fruit.
- (3) Is the minister aware of the valuable economic contribution the growers provide to central Victoria.

**ANSWER:**

I am informed that:

- (1) In response to the member's question, I am able to confirm that I am aware of the intense hail event which affected a small number of apple growers in the Harcourt area on 10 and 11 February 2012.
- (2) I am advised by my department that damage to crops resulting from this event caused some growers to lose up to 50 per cent of their crops, while others experienced a significant downgrade in crop quality.  
  
Extreme weather events are a normal and accepted business risk for horticulture in Victoria. Managing this risk should be factored into each grower's annual business and operating plan.
- (3) Apple growing in the Harcourt area of Victoria is a valuable contributor to Victoria's horticulture sector, currently accounting for around 40 per cent of Victoria's apple production and generating around \$80 million in value each year.

**Education: Corio Norlane education regeneration project**

**2645.** Mr EREN to ask the Minister for Education — what is the time line for funding and completing each stage of the Corio Norlane education regeneration project.

**ANSWER:**

I am informed as follows:

The Victorian coalition government is committed to upgrading government primary and secondary schools across the state. Priority projects included in the capital works program for the first term of government are identified in the *Victorian Liberal Nationals Coalition Plan for Education*, released in November 2010. Further schools were identified for capital funding in the Victorian state budget 2011–12, released on 3 May 2011.

The Victorian government is currently engaged in state budget planning to determine how best to allocate public resources in the 2012–13 financial year. The outcome of this process will be announced in the 2012–13 Victorian budget released in May.

Stage 1 funding for the Corio Norlane education regeneration project was received in the 2010–11 Victorian state budget with a total allocation of \$11.45 million for construction to take place on four campuses of Northern Bay P–12 College: Hendy Street, Peacock Avenue, Wexford Court and Goldsworthy Road.

Stage 1 works have now been completed on three of these sites, and the Wexford Court campus project is due for completion in March 2012.
