Answers

- Page 6 = Bourke Street
- Page 7
 - Blue dot
 - Large entry room = Vestibule
 - A message about the importance of people to watch over and discuss matters
- Page 8
 - Queen Victoria
 - Queen of the British Empire when 'Victoria' was a colony and parliament here began
 - Former premiers
 - Women not allowed to vote in politics until just over a century ago (let alone stand for election)
- Page 9
 - Green
 - Red
- Page 11
 - The Mace in the Lower House (since the theft, it has been replaced)
- Page 15
 - 2004 – a more aware public / development of attitudes
- Page 18
 - Right-hand side / write notes
 - Brake / break
 - Steal / steel
 - Council / counsel
 - Talk / torque
 - Polls / poles
- Page 19
 - 13th Century = 1201 – 1300 (although some people will argue that the answer should be 1200 – 1299)
 - Missed by five minutes
