SIR,

In reply to your letter of the 26th instant, requesting to be furnished with a return shewing the amount of assessment charged during the past year on Stock depastured on Crown Lands leased to the occupants of adjacent purchased land, I have the honor to state that no assessment has been charged on the Stock so depastured, as the Assessment Act applies (16th clause regulations) only to Stock depastured beyond the settled districts, and the class of the land above referred to falls within their limits.
