Central Province.—This is bounded on the north by a line corresponding with the borough boundary line of the city of Melbourne, but extending eight miles in length; on the east and west by lines passing north and south at a distance of four miles from Batman's Hill, at either side; and on the south by the Bay. Besides the six electoral districts of Melbourne, St. Kilda, Collingwood, South Melbourne, Richmond, and Williamstown, it includes Hawthorn, Northcote, Flemington, and part of the parish of Cut-paw-paw.

South Province.—This embraces the counties of Evelyn and Mornington, and all the county of Bourke beyond the Central Province.

South-Western Province.—The counties of Grant, Grenville, and Polworth.

Western Province.—The counties of Ripon, Hampden, Heytesbury, Villiers, Normanby, Dundas, and Follett.

North-Western Province.—The counties of Talbot, Dalhousie, the Wimmera, and Loddon districts.

Eastern Province.—Anglesey and Rodney, the Murray District, and Gipps Land.

Note.—The divisions of the rural population made in this and the following Tables are, to a certain extent, arbitrary, and are not to be taken as correct representations of the numbers of the agricultural or pastoral population. It is but an attempt at an approximation, for the purpose of shewing how far the different pursuits of the people have affected their civil condition. In making the divisions, it has been assumed that those districts are chiefly agricultural where parishes have been formed and the land sold; but, in point of fact, a considerable portion of the pastoral population still continues to reside within the surveyed country. In like manner, the gold-fields districts embrace many of the largest stations, the inhabitants of which have necessarily been taken together.
