#### EXAMINATION AND SALARIES OF TEACHERS.

With reference to paragraph 8, section 3, of the Regulations of the Commissioners of National Education as to the Examination and Salaries of Teachers: Notice is hereby given that the reduction of £5 per centum upon all salaries and allowances paid to Teachers, Workmistresses, Pupil Teachers, and Paid Monitors, will be continued during the present year.

#### EXAMINATION AND SALARIES OF TEACHERS.

With reference to paragraph 9, section 3 of the Regulations of the Commissioners of National Education as to the Examination and Salaries of Teachers: Notice is hereby given that from the 1st April, 1860, the following will be the rates of allowances in lieu of house rent:—

For single teachers, £20 per annum  
For married teachers, £30 „

one-half of which amounts will have to be provided by the patrons of the school.
