REPORT.

HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE, Yarra Bend, Melbourne, 13th May 1873.

Sir.

In accordance with provisions of section 56 of the Lunacy Statute, I have the honor to submit to you my Annual Report of the state and condition of the asylums in Victoria. Appended to the Report is the series of tables now in general use in asylums, and approved, as affording information on all essential matters in connection with the condition and treatment of the insane.

Having, in my last Report, entered fully into the history and position of Victorian asylums as compared with those of other countries, it is not possible to dwell at length on the general results indicated by an examination of the tables without entering upon a mere repetition of what was so recently laid before you. The same reason made it seem unnecessary and unimportant to submit at an earlier period a report merely corroborative of the conclusions of a former year. There are, however, a few points on which brief observations may be made.

I.—INCREASE OF LUNACY BY ACCUMULATION.

On the 1st of January 1871 there were in the public asylums 1849 patients; during the year 546 were admitted, 258 were discharged recovered or relieved, and 132 deaths occurred. On the 31st December of the same year the number remaining was 2037, leaving a total increase of 188 above the previous year. It is highly satisfactory to observe, by reference to Appendix A, Table 2, that there is a decrease of 20 in the number admitted as compared with 1870, whilst at the same time there has been an addition to the population, as shown by the Census Returns, of over 26,000 persons. The total increase in the number of the insane of 188 is due to increase by accumulation, which, according to opinions expressed in former reports, is a thing to be expected in this colony for some time to come, but in no degree indicating an increase of insanity in the population.

II.—Proportion of Insane to Population.

The following table will show at a glance the ratio of the insane to the population, and the rate at which it has been advancing both in England and in the colony during the last ten years:—

The ratio of one insane person in every 369 of the population in Victoria, as compared with one in 393 in England, shows a percentage in favor of England, but so slight as to be scarcely appreciable.

III. RECOVERIES AND MORTALITY.

Recoveries.—The proportion of the recoveries calculated on the numbers admitted has been 41 02 in every hundred, while the average ratio in England has

been 33 or in every hundred.

Mortality.—The proportion of deaths on the average numbers resident in the asylums has been 6.94 in every hundred, while in the English asylums it has been 10.23. Both these results show considerably in favor of the Victorian asylums. low average of deaths no doubt, to a great extent, accounts for the larger number of insane to the population in Victoria than in England for the year 1871, and which is not unlikely to be an exceptional occurrence.

Statutory visits of inspection were paid to the several asylums during the year, and the numerical changes and results in the various establishments will be

found in the tables appended to this Report.
