TUESDAY, 18TH DECEMBER 1877.

GIPPSLAND AND GOULBURN VALLEY RAILWAY BILLS.—The Order of the Day for the consideration of the Message from the Legislative Council on these Bill having been read, Mr. Berry moved, That a Committee be appointed to confer with a Committee of the Legislative Council as to the above lines of railway ; such Committee to consist of Mr. Grant, Mr. Woods, Mr. Orr, Mr. Dixon, Mr. Munro, Mr. Gaunson, Mr. Patterson, Mr. Fergusson, Mr. Sharpe, and Mr. Berry : five to form a quorum.

Question—put and resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered—That a Message be transmitted to the Legislative Council acquainting them of the above resolution.
