For the Construction of the Goulburn Valley Railway authorized by Act 42 Vict. No. 603, £ s. d.
Estimated length 48 miles 18 chains 23 links, at £5,750 per mile—£277,310.
Estimated expenditure to 30th June 1879, say one-half of the total cost 138,655 0 0

NOTE.—This expenditure to form a portion of the item of £650,000 authorized to be expended under the above Loan Act for the purposes of the Railway Construction Act 41 Vict. No. 580.

ACT No. 531, SCHEDULE 2, ITEM 1.

For the Construction of a Line of Railway from South Yarra to Oakleigh authorized by Act 42 Vict. No. 604. Estimated length 6 miles 72 chains, at £25,000 per mile.
Estimated Expenditure 172,500 0 0

NOTE.—This expenditure to form a portion of the item of £650,000 authorized to be expended under the above Act 531 for the purposes of the Construction Act 580. To be recouped from the proceeds of the next Loan raised for purposes of Railway Construction.
