Question No. 1.—What was the cost of the erection of the Mint?

Answer.—The building, machinery, fittings, and furniture cost £68,350.

Question No. 2.—With compound interest added at 5 per cent., what would be the total capital up to date?

Answer.—From the end of 1872 (the date of completion) to 30th September 1880, the cost and compound interest at 5 per cent. amounts to £99,782.

Question No. 3.—How much land is occupied by the Mint premises?

Answer.—Two acres 1 rood and 26 perches.

Question No. 4.—What is the estimated value of such land?

Answer.—£8,500.
