“THE FISHERIES ACTS AMENDMENT ACT 1878.”—NOTICE.—LAKE TERANG.

IN accordance with the provisions of the 4th clause of *The Fisheries Act Amendment Act 1878*, it is hereby notified, for general information, that it is intended, at the expiration of one month from the date of this notice appearing in the *Government Gazette*, to move the Governor in Council, under powers conferred by the 3rd clause of the said Act, to proclaim the period from the first day of April to the thirtieth day of September in each year (both days inclusive) to be a close season for all species of fish so far as Lake Terang and its tributaries are concerned.
