The Governor informs the Legislative Assembly that he has, on this day, at the Government Offices, given the Royal Assent to the undermentioned Acts of the present Session, presented to him by the Clerk of the Parliaments, viz. :—

“An Act to amend ‘The Melbourne Harbor Trust Act 1876.’”

“An Act to re-enact and continue ‘The Fisheries Act Amendment Act 1878.’”

“An Act to continue various Expiring Laws.”

“An Act to authorize the construction of Additional Works on the Victorian State Railways
“and for other purposes.”

“An Act to sanction the issue and application of certain sums of money as Loans for Water
“Supply in the Country Districts.”

“An Act to provide for reimbursing Members of the Legislative Assembly their expenses in
“relation to their attendance in Parliament.”
