GENERAL REGULATIONS RESPECTING

ADDITION TO GENERAL REGULATION No. 33, CLAUSE A.

PURSUANT TO ACT 22 VICTORIA, No. 86.

GENERAL REGULATIONS RESPECTING PUBLIC ACCOUNTS, UNDER ACT
22 VIC., No. 86.

THE following addition to the General Regulation, No. 33, clause A, to come into operation on and after the first day of January, 1884, has been approved by the Governor in Council :—

Nevertheless payment of salaries, wages, and fixed allowances may not be made to others than principals, except in cases where the acquittance of the principal cannot be obtained, owing to his absence on leave, or through sickness, or some other unavoidable cause. In all such cases the order for payment to the agent must be initialled by the permanent Head of the Department to which the officer signing it belongs.

This Regulation not to apply to the orders which may be given by the subordinate Teachers of the Education Department in favour of the Head Teachers of their respective schools, nor to any exceptional cases which may be made the subject of a special order by the Treasurer of Victoria.
