NOTICE OF PROCLAMATION TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF ANY TRAMMEL, TRAWL, OR OTHER NET OR ENGINE, WHETHER FIXED OR UNFIXED, TO BE EMPLOYED IN FISHING IN THAT PORTION OF HOBSON'S BAY INCLUDED WITHIN A LINE DRAWN FROM THE EXTREME OUTER OR EASTERN SIDE OF THE BREAKWATER PIER TO THE INNER OR EASTERN EXTREMITY OF THE RAILWAY PIER AT WILLIAMSTOWN.

PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT IN PURSUANCE OF SECT. 4 OF ACT No. 622.

“THE FISHERIES ACT AMENDMENT ACT 1878.”—HOBSON'S BAY.

IT is hereby notified for general information, in accordance with the provisions of the 4th clause of *The Fisheries Act Amendment Act 1878*, that it is intended, at the expiration of one month from the date of this notice appearing in the *Government Gazette*, to move His Excellency the Governor in Council, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette*, under the powers conferred by the 3rd clause of the above-cited Act, to prohibit the use of any trammel, trawl, or other net or engine, whether fixed or unfixed, to be employed in fishing in that portion of Hobson's Bay included within a line drawn from the extreme outer or eastern side of the Breakwater Pier to the inner or eastern extremity of the Railway Pier at Williamstown.
