ALTERATION OF REGULATION No. 29.

**H**IS Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve of the following alteration in the Order in Council of 12th September, 1887, which appears in the *Gazette* of 1887, page 2703, specifying who are to certify to accounts for expenditure out of the Licensing Act 1885 Fund, viz.:—

*For* No. 6. Compensation, &c. The Licensing Court under its seal and the Secretary to the Law Department.

*Read* No. 6. Compensation, &c. The arbitrator or the arbitrators and umpire or the umpire awarding the compensation, and in either case the Crown Solicitor.
