MINOR ARTICLES.

IN accordance with the provisions of section 8 of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890*, I hereby order that the following Minor Articles used in the manufacture of dutiable articles shall be admitted free of duty, such order to take effect from the 29th September, 1891 :—

Boots and Shoes.

Button holes made of leather, called patent crimped.

Miscellaneous.

Stoppers for glass preserving jars—metal, plain or lined with any other material.
