MINOR ARTICLES USED IN MANUFACTURE.

PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT PURSUANT TO LAW.

MINOR ARTICLES.

IN accordance with the provisions of section 8 of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890*, I hereby order that the following minor articles used in the manufacture of dutiable articles shall be admitted free of duty, such order to take effect from the 16th inst.:—

Hooks, snap or spring, for saddlers.
Spurs, stilts, and thimbles used in the manufacture of pottery.
Studs of metal, used in making leather pouches.
Suspenders, dress, used in making apparel.
Iron tubes in the rough, used in the manufacture of bedsteads.
