MINOR ARTICLES.

IN accordance with the provisions of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890*, I hereby cancel the orders directing that

Labels,
 Leathers (Real or Imitation),
 Tips and Sides—cut, but not made up,

be admitted free as Minor Articles used in the manufacture of Hats and Caps, and in lieu thereof direct that the following articles shall be so admitted as Minor Articles used in the manufacture of such dutiable articles, viz.:—

Leathers (Real or Imitation),	} When not stamped.
Tips and Sides—cut, but not made up	

This order is to take effect from the 30th March, 1893.
