MINOR ARTICLES.

**I**N accordance with the provisions of section 8 of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890*, I hereby order that the undermentioned articles be admitted free of duty as Minor Articles, viz.:—

Knives used in the manufacture of hand tobacco-cutters up to  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches in length (unfinished).  
 Knives used in the manufacture of tin-openers (unfinished).
