CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DUTIES ACT 1890.

RATE OF DUTY ON LEATHER.

PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT PURSUANT TO LAW.

Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890.

WHEREAS certain leather known as "Persian Goat," being black in colour, is imported into Victoria, and the said leather, in my opinion, is apparently a substitute for that known as "Persian Sheep," and the said "Persian Sheep" leather is dutiable at the rate of 35 per cent. ad valorem, it is hereby notified, for general information, that I do hereby, in accordance with the powers conferred upon me by section 5 of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890*, order and direct that the same rate of duty shall be charged upon black Persian Goat leather as upon Persian Sheep leather.
