MINOR ARTICLES.

IN accordance with the provisions of section 8 of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act 1890*, I hereby order that the undermentioned goods used in the manufacture of boots and shoes be admitted into Victoria free of duty as Minor Articles, viz. :—

Welts and facings (not exceeding half-an-inch in width). This order to take effect from the 12th February, 1895.
