THE Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has approved the subjoined Scale of Fees to be taken in respect of any approval or certificate regarding the positions of load-lines on ships, given in pursuance of the provisions of section 4 of the *Marine Act 1892* (57 Vict. No. 1357), viz.:—
