ORDER IN COUNCIL.

---

PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT PURSUANT TO LAW.

---

**T**HE Governor in Council has been pleased to approve that, notwithstanding anything contained in any previous Orders in Council fixing the charges for telephonic connexions, the rates to be paid by Charitable Institutions shall be one-half the ordinary rates; and that the undermentioned charges shall be made for connexion with the Telephone Exchanges at Bendigo and Warrnambool respectively, from the 1st January, 1895:—

**BENDIGO.**

Providing line of one mile or under with one telephone set (complete) and service at the Exchange from 8.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.—£6 per annum.

**WARRNAMBOOL.**

Providing line of one mile or under, one telephone set (complete) and service at Exchange—£8 per annum.
