NOTE.—In this estimate of population allowance has been made for the unrecorded departures which have occurred since the Census of 1891 was taken. Such departures, between the date of the Census and the end of 1894, are estimated to have amounted to 24,134, viz., 18,804 of males and 5,330 of females. Had this allowance not been made, the population of Victoria would have apparently amounted at the end of 1894 to 1,203,237, viz., 626,063 males and 577,174 females.
