 PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT PURSUANT TO LAW.

DUTY ON INDIARUBBER TIRES.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 6 of the *Customs and Excise Duties Act* 1890, I hereby direct that duty be charged upon Indiarubber Tires, not being for perambulators or children's carriages, as parts of carriages n.o.e. at the rate of 25 per cent.

This order to take effect on and after the 21st May, 1895.
