VICTORIAN RAILWAYS, Melbourne, 4th November, 1896.

To the Honorable the Minister of Railways.

SIR.

In accordance with the provisions of the 58th section of the Railways Act, No. 1135, I have the honour to submit my Report for the quarter ending 30th September, 1896.

For comparative purposes the figures relating to the corresponding quarter of 1895 are also given.

The revenue shows an increase of £21,170, and the expenditure an increase of £753, the net increase for the quarter being £20,417.

It is gratifying to note that the passenger traffic shows an increase, but there has not yet been any substantial improvement in the goods business.

As I only entered upon my duties on the 1st July, I have not been able to visit more than comparatively few of the country lines. I have, however, been able to travel over the whole of the suburban system.

The lines which I have inspected appear generally to have been well maintained. I noticed, however, that additional accommodation was necessary in some places, and that a number of station buildings required painting and repairs. I also recognised the necessity for better passenger vehicles on some lines, and that the lighting of the carriages required improvement.

The whole of these works are now being proceeded with as rapidly as possible.

Amongst the other important matters to which I have had to give earnest consideration during the quarter, I may mention the revision of the fares and freights, the classification and general regrading of the staff, and the re-organization of the stores and other branches of the service.

I attach reports from the Engineer for Existing Lines on the general condition of the way and works, and from the Chief Mechanical Engineer on the state of the rolling-stock.

Returns relating to the staff, &c., are also submitted herewith.

The work of improving the gradients was in progress during the quarter on the lines from Ballarat to Ararat, Seymour to Wangaratta, and Geelong to Colac, whilst that from Dimboola to Wail was completed on the 8th July.

Melbourne, 5th November, 1896. I have the honour to report that the rolling-stock was kept in good running order and condition during the quarter ended 30th September, 1896. Contracts were let for 150 louvre waggons, U class; 10 insulated trucks, T class; and 100 medium waggons, I class.

The workshops at Newport and Port Melbourne have been on full time since 6th July last; 22 iron sheep trucks. L class have been turned out during the cuerter.

The deliveries under the above contracts will commence in about a fortnight's time. Tenders have been called for 200 iron medium waggons, I class.

The drawings, &c., are in preparation for the new car stock.
