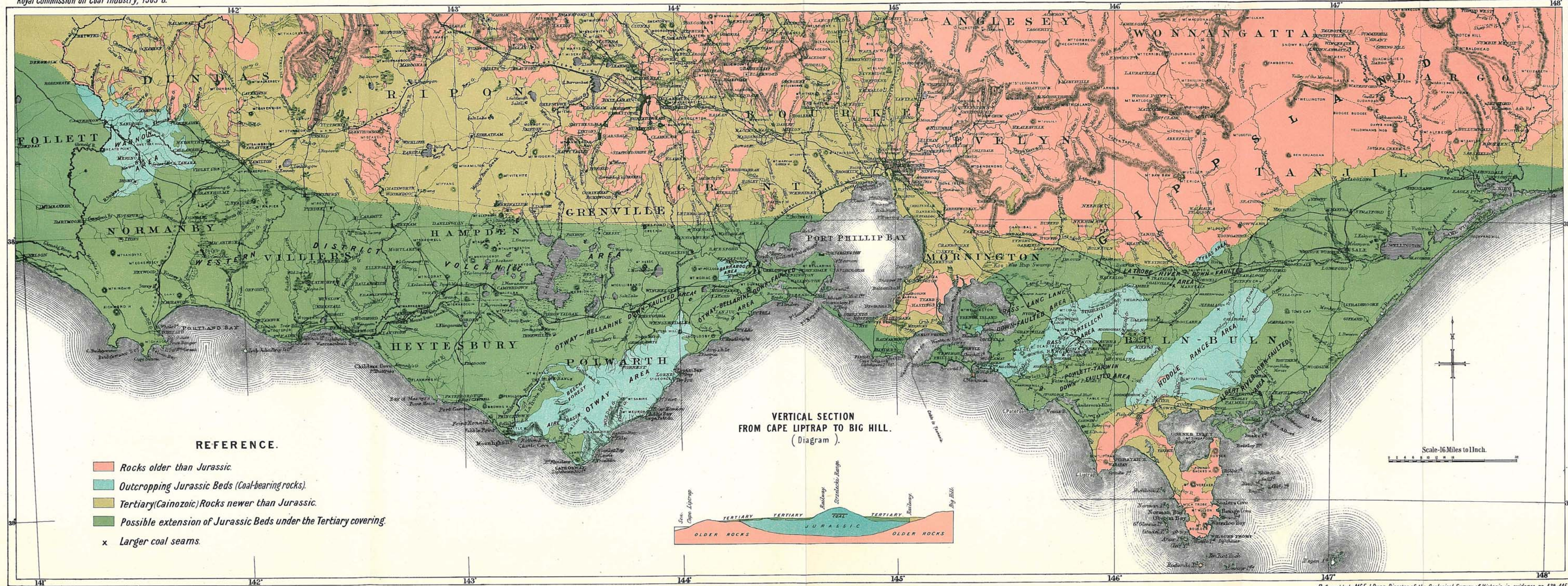


SKETCH MAP OF SOUTHERN PORTION OF VICTORIA,
